

PIDGEONS of Edmonton-1 (Thomas), London

Thomas PIDGEON was the second son of John PIDGEON and Esther RICH, who were married at Hatfield, where Thomas was born, (see the [PIDGEONS of Hertfordshire & London](#) family tree). Thomas and his brothers moved to Edmonton in north London, and it was at nearby Chingford that Thomas married **Susan WARWICK**.

The baptism of their eldest son Thomas has not been found. However, the marriage certificate of Thomas junior and Eliza LOVETT says his father was Thomas, a horse keeper.
